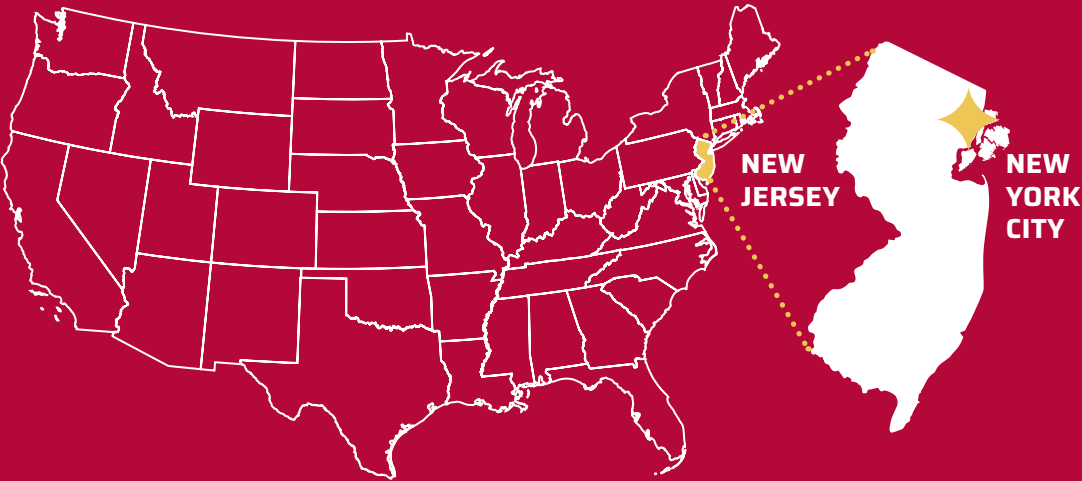

READY TO BE PART OF THE STEVENS COMMUNITY?

A Checklist of Application Requirements:

- Common Application
- Official high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation
- \$70 USD application fee
- Test scores (test optional for Fall 2023 first-year applicants)

**If electing to submit test scores, at least one of the
following standardized test options is required:**

- SAT I
- ACT
- Two AP exams: calculus and either chemistry or physics
- Two SAT subject tests: math and either chemistry or physics
- International Baccalaureate predicted grades with two higher-level exam scores in math and science

**If you are an international student applying to Stevens
and English is not your first language, you must
demonstrate English proficiency with one of the following:**

- TOEFL (*minimum score of 80 iBT*)
- IELTS (*minimum score of 6 overall*)
- SAT I Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (minimum score of 550)
- Duolingo English Test (*minimum score of 105*)
- Pearson PTE Academic Test (*minimum score of 53*)
